## **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

Arthur Joseph Walker was born at Ipswich, Queensland on 13 May 1903. He entered the Navy from Sydney on 30<sup>th</sup> May 1921. He was fortunate enough to take part in the world tour by HMAS Adelaide from 5 August 1922 to 28 May 1925. He left the Navy on 16 August 1928 to be with a young family. Navy records show that he volunteered for the Navy by letter on 5<sup>th</sup> February 1941 during the height of the war and was accepted. He re-entered the Navy on 21<sup>st</sup> March 1941 and was posted to HMAS Penguin until 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1941 and then posted to HMAS Sydney on 4<sup>th</sup> April 1941. He was promoted to Leading Cook on 6 August 1941.

He married Edith Beryl Warrington on 22 August 1928. They had 2 children, Roslyn Beryl and ArthurLeslie. The family were notified of his death when they were living at Badgery Ave Homebush NSW.

Arthur Joseph Walker's service records received from the Department of Defence (Navy Office) by letter on 20 April 1998 show that he was promoted to Leading Cook on 6 August 1941.
